PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR / CITY ENGINEER

- a) **Updates**

Public Works Director / City Engineer Bachmeier provided the following updates:

- **Spring Preparations:** Cleaning catch basins and sweeping streets.
- **Hadley and 36 Interchange:** North frontage road to close week of March 31.
- **2019 Street Reconstruction:** Advertising for bids.
- **Winter Parking:** Overnight parking on city streets resumes April 1.
- **Load Limits:** Began March 15, typically remain in place for eight weeks.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

a) Border Foods – 7049 – 10th Street – Site Plan (Taco Bell)

City Planner Shively reviewed a request from Border Foods Inc. to construct a 2,706 square foot Taco Bell restaurant at 7049 – 10th Street in Bergen Plaza.

In response to questions from the City Council, the applicant noted that the parking spots provided continuity with the existing site; the center median would be grass; hours would typically be 7 AM to 1 or 2 AM, later on weekends; and construction planned to begin in June and be completed in three months.

In response to a question from Council Member Ingebrigtsen, City Planner Shively noted that related signage would be approved administratively unless a request is made for dynamic signage.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCIL MEMBER ZABEL, SECONDED BY COUNCIL MEMBER SWEDBERG, TO WAIVE READING AND ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 2019-26, APPROVING A SITE PLAN FOR A 2,706 SQUARE FOOT RESTAURANT AT 7049 – 10TH STREET (BORDER FOODS – TACO BELL).

Mayor Reinke encouraged residents to subscribe to project updates on both the 94/494/694 and Hadley and 36 interchange projects. He also noted that he had recently attended a meeting with Public Works Director/City Engineer Bachmeier at which the Minnesota Department of Transportation reviewed all their road projects.
