### **PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR/CITY ENGINEER**

- a) **Project Update**

Public Works Director/City Engineer Bachmeier provided updates on the following:

- Highway 36 and Hadley Interchange – Concrete in north and south of the bridge deck.
- 2019 Street Improvements – Final base work being completed in all neighborhoods.
- Dog Park – Fence installation near completed.

In response to an inquiry from Council Member Zabel, Public Works Director/City Engineer Bachmeier noted that staff has been working with Xcel Energy to expedite connecting power to the streets lights in the northern neighborhoods of the 2019 Street Reconstruction project area. He added that Xcel Energy's deadline of September 13 is both unexplainable and unacceptable.

Council Member Swedberg commented on the video updates showing the progress on the Highway 36 and Hadley Avenue interchange project.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**a) Toole Design Bike and Pedestrian Plan Agreement**

Community Development Director Streetar reviewed a request to enter an agreement with the Toole Design Group to update the city's bike and pedestrian plan, as noted in the 2040 Comprehensive Plan. He noted that the project would be funded by the Park Tool Escrow Fund in 2019 and the fund reimbursed in 2020.

**A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCIL MEMBER ZABEL, SECONDED BY COUNCIL MEMBER INGEBRIGTSON, TO AUTHORIZE THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR ON-CALL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKDALE AND TOOLE DESIGN GROUP LLC RELATING TO THE PREPARATION OF AN UPDATED BIKE AND PEDESTRIAN PLAN.**
